END OF YEAR GIVING REMINDERS

For a donation to be considered deductible in 2024, you must do the following: **Date the check in 2024 AND** Check must either be placed in the collection basket or office by December 31 **OR** if the check is mailed, it must be postmarked on or before December 31, 2024. Therefore:

Checks brought into the office in January (even if dated in December) will be NOT be deductible in 2024. Checks mailed with a postmark in January (even if dated in December) will be NOT be deductible in 2024.

In both of these cases, the donations will be deductible in 2025.

Support My Church and Save on My Taxes?! What's Better than That?

Want a way to boost your tax savings beyond the newly increased standard deduction? If you are 70 ½ or older, you can use your IRA to make a gift to your parish, school, diocese or ministry and save on taxes! Normally, a distribution from your IRA is taxed as ordinary income. However, federal tax law now allows you to make a distribution each year from your IRA to a qualifying charity and it is not subject to federal income tax.

Transfers must be made directly from your IRA administrator to a qualifying 501c3 charitable organization. For more information contact our parish office or your IRA administrator.

WeShare users

If you are changing your WeShare amount for 2025, you must go into WeShare to update the amount or call the office and ask for Deb to make that change in January. (Filling out a pledge form does not change WeShare amounts.)






