Weekly Reflection

Living the Gospel, Whatever It Costs

When we think of Jesus's great love for us, his compassion for friends and strangers alike, and his call to love one another, his words of division in today's Gospel may surprise or unsettle us. Is he telling us that he desires families to be torn apart? Absolutely not! But he is warning us plainly that following him by truly living his commandments can put us at odds with those we care for most. Luke's Gospel shows us that this is not contradiction, but consequence. The same fire of the Spirit that brings life also burns away what is false. The same truth that sets us free also unsettles those who resist it. Peace is the ultimate promise of God's Kingdom, but Jesus tells us that before that peace comes, his followers must be prepared for the cost of discipleship.

To be holy, literally meaning "to be set apart for God", means our lives are shaped not by what is popular, but by what is faithful. In today's culture, it is easier to remain silent than to speak the truth in love. But Jesus does not call us to comfort; he calls us to courage. We are not called to be agreeable at the expense of truth, but to be kind even when kindness is costly. We are not called to "live and let live," but to admonish the sinner without judgment. We are not called to turn away from those who are unsure, but to counsel the doubtful with patience. We are not called to keep our faith private, but to instruct the ignorant, bear wrongs patiently, forgive offenses willingly, comfort the afflicted, and pray for the living and the dead. These are not easy commands, but they are the way of love.

Living this way will set us apart. The culture of relativism tells us that truth is whatever we make of it, but discipleship tells us that truth is a person: Jesus Christ. And proclaiming him, in word and in action, will sometimes cost us comfort, reputation, or relationships. But it will also give us the only peace that endures. Following Jesus is urgent work. Every day, we are given chances to speak the truth, to offer forgiveness, to act with courage, and every day we can either take them or let them pass. Division will come when we live for the Gospel, but so will joy, freedom, and peace in him. This week, ask for the grace to see the moments when faith calls you to step forward, and the strength to respond without hesitation. May our witness draw others to the fire of Christ's love, even when it costs us.
