There is always so much going in in our Family of Parishes! Our present challenges aside, I love everyone's energy and enthusiasm! On Saturday, June 22nd our Biblically based Family Faith Formation program wrapped up the year. I'm so proud of the commitment our 5 students and their parents showed by attending each session. Our focus this year was on encountering the person of Jesus. In our first session they prepared for Jesus' coming learning about Advent and the liturgical year enjoying a tour of the sacristy. Our second session taught us who the person of Jesus is as we explored the seven "I am" statements in John's Gospel. Our third session helped us understand how to get to know Jesus better through the sacramental life. And our final session taught us how to live as a disciple as we learned about the Beatitudes and living a moral life. After each session families were given ways to foster the faith at home throughout the month. I pray all of our young people have a safe, fun, and faith-filled summer!

On **Sunday, June 23rd** Fr Mark Kreis offered a blessing for Joseph and Mary, who returned to Saint John Kanty with family to celebrate their 60th wedding anniversary, it is always a joy to welcome parishioners "home!"

Where are we with the diocesan rightsizing process?

- * Both St. John Kanty / St. Adalbert & St. John Gualbert are preparing counter-proposals. As part of the process, they will have to recommend another parish to close in their place as the family must reduce by the number of parishes recommended to close and merge.
- * Counter-proposals are to be submitted by July 15th.

- * Between July 15th and August 23rd, two representatives from each parish making an alternative recommendation will meet with the Review Committee to discuss their proposal. The Review Committee consists of: 1. Fr. Bryan Zielenieski, Vicar for Renewal 2. Deacon Greg Moran, Strategic planning for Renewal 3. Vicar Forane 4. Diocesan Pastoral Council Representative 5. Lay leader TBD.
- * Because a parish will be recommended to close in place of the parish making the counter-proposal, that parish will also be invited to send two representatives to attend the dialogue with the Review Committee.
- * Decisions on acceptance or rejection of counter proposals will be given within **24 hours** of the meeting.

As I explained to the members of our Pastoral Councils at our Family-wide meeting, there is no easy way to close a parish. We know, during the Journey of Faith and Grace, the Diocese was more heavy handed in deciding what parish should stay open and what should close. Naturally, this angered many people. Our current process, conscious of our need to downsize, the Diocese is willing to hear alternative recommendations based upon data and facts. The unfortunate result is that this process pits parishes against each other.

It is understandable that everyone wants to save their parish so let us proceed with a compassionate heart as these dialogues will soon take place.

There is also no "one-size-fits-all" process. Elsewhere in the diocese with parishes that have multiple, underutilized worship sites, they have been very amenable to accepting the recommendations.


