



From Fr. Cole Webster

Enclosed in the bulletins of St. Stanislaus, St. John Kanty / Adalbert, St. Katharine Drexel, & St. John Gualbert is a Statistical Summation for the end of Fiscal Year 2023-2024, and on the reverse side, the past Fiscal Year's Financial Report for that particular parish. I cannot thank Frank, Noreen, and Barb enough for all their hard work in compiling the year end reports for four parishes.

St. Stanislaus, St. John Gualbert, & St. Katharine Drexel finished this past Fiscal Year with a surplus. St. John Kanty / St. Adalbert finished with a deficit significantly lower than budgeted. However, a major concern is that the surplus at St. Stanislaus & St. John Gulabert was due to non-reoccurring bequests and St. Katharine Drexel's surplus was from insurance reimbursements. If those are backed out, each parish is in deficit spending.

Despite our challenges, we were able to make substantial progress this past year. The Social Center at St. Stanislaus received much needed plumbing and electrical work, updated Ansul Fire Suppression Systems, and repairs to Kitchen Hoods and Exhaust Systems. A new exterior lighting system was installed at St. John Kanty, insurance arrears reduced, and porch and flashing repairs at St. Adalbert. St. John Gulalbert leveraged their financial resources by reinvesting in funds with higher returns. Lastly, St. Katharine Drexel converted their former parish offices and rectory garages into the new home for the Lovejoy Food Panty strengthening the support they receive from Catholic Charities.

I cannot thank each of you for your support of time, talent, and treasure. Together we are all beacons of light radiating the love and joy of Jesus Christ to our territory here in Greater East Buffalo! ST. PAUL CENTER FOR BIBLICAL THEOLOGY

The new Church year begins with a plea for God's visitation. "Oh that you would rend the heavens and come down," the prophet Isaiah cries in today's First Reading.

In today's Psalm, too, we hear the anguished voice of Israel, imploring God to look down from His heavenly throne—to save and shepherd His people.

Today's readings are relatively brief. Their language and "message" are deceptively simple. But we should take note of the serious mood and penitential aspect of the Liturgy today as the people of Israel recognize their sinfulness, their failures to keep God's covenant, their inability to save themselves.

And in this Advent season, we should see our own lives in the experience of Israel. As we examine our consciences, can't we, too, find that we often harden our hearts, refuse His rule, wander from His ways, withhold our love from Him?

God is faithful, Paul reminds us in today's Epistle. He is our Father. He has hearkened to the cry of His children, coming down from heaven for Israel's sake and for ours to redeem us from our exile from God, to restore us to His love.

In Jesus, we have seen the Father (see <u>John 14:8–9</u>). The Father has let His face shine upon us. He is the good shepherd (see <u>John 10:11–15</u>) come to guide us to the heavenly kingdom. No matter how far we have strayed, He will give us new life if we turn to Him, if we call upon His holy name, if we pledge anew never again to withdraw from Him.

As Paul says today, He has given us every spiritual gift—especially the Eucharist and penance—to strengthen us as we await Christ's final coming. He will keep us firm to the end—if we let Him.

So, in this season of repentance, we should heed the warning repeated three times by our Lord in today's Gospel: be watchful, for we know not the hour when the Lord of the house will return.




