## From Fr. Cole Webster

This past Saturday, we concluded the month of June by welcoming the Knights of Columbus from the Fr. Justin Council to St. John Gualbert as part of their Pilgrim Icon Program. This year's icon that travels to different Knight of Columbus Councils was an image of the Sacred Heart blessed by Pope Francis; a reproduction of the 1767 image painted by Pompeo Batoni venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament began at 3:30pm. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy was prayed along with the Litany to the Sacred Heart, a prayer of Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and a Prayer for Vocations. An outdoor Eucharistic Procession followed Mass and a lite reception was enjoyed by all.

Thank you also to everyone who participated in our Friday Sacred Heart Devotions at St. Stanislaus and St. John Gualbert.

While I announced from the pulpit's what our respective Chapter 11 contributions will be, some parish leaders asked that it also be put in writing. ## ST. PAUL CENTER For Biblical Theology

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Cycle C)

Jesus has a vision in this week's Gospel - Satan falling like lightning from the sky, the enemy vanquished by the missionary preaching of His Church.

Sent out by Jesus to begin gathering the nations into the harvest of divine judgment (see <u>Isaiah 27:12-13;</u> <u>Joel 4:13</u>), the 70 are a sign of the continuing mission of the Church.

Carrying out the work of the 70, the Church proclaims the coming of God's kingdom, offers His blessings of peace and mercy to every household on earth - "every town and place He intended to visit."

Our Lord's tone is solemn today. For in the preaching of the Church "the kingdom of God is at hand," the time of decision has come for every person. Those who do not receive His messengers will be doomed like Sodom.

But those who believe will find peace and mercy, protection and nourishment in the bosom of the Church, the Mother Zion we celebrate in this week's beautiful First Reading, the "Israel of God" Paul blesses in this week's Epistle.

The Church is a new family of faith (see <u>Galatians 6:10</u>) in which we receive a new name that will endure forever (see <u>Isaiah 66:22</u>), a name written in heaven.

In this week's Psalm we sing of God's "tremendous deeds among men" throughout salvation history. But of all the works of God, none has been greater than what He has wrought by the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Changing the sea into dry land was but an anticipation and preparation for our passing over, for what Paul calls the "new creation."



As we celebrate the conclusion of another successful school year, we are filled with joy and anticipation as we welcome our new Superintendent, Mrs. Joleen Dimitroff. Her leadership brings renewed hope for the future of Catholic education in our community.

Our recent strategic planning process has yielded a bold and inspiring vision: *Forming Disciples in Catholic Schools.* This vision challenges us to reimagine Catholic education in light of today's social, demographic, and financial realities. It also outlines an ambitious timeline for implementation, one that Mrs. Dimitroff has thoughtfully reviewed with her team, outside advisors, and several parents. From this consultation, two key insights have emerged:


