


Enrollment




Budget: Income & Expenses

Income: \$703,038


School fundraising totals:

Providing our own specialist teachers with the end of shared time classes with the public school increased expenses. Aging infrastructure and rising insurance costs also increased expenses.




Star Math





New Roof


Thanks to generous support from several donors and St. John's Catholic Parish, SJAS received in new roof!

6th Grade Graduation


Efforts were made to make the 6th grade graduation program more family-focused. A God in All Things Award was introduced.




- 1- Teacher review of **social studies** curriculum this year to implement in 2026-2027.


- 1- **Gym** renovations and **PE equipment** improvements.
