

Thoughts from the Pastor's Desk ...



Dear friends of Blessed Trinity,
Heaven is the state of being perfectly united with God. It is having come to our fullest potential in Christ. A seed bursting with life. A treasure in a field come upon and eagerly pursued. Heaven is participating fully in the eternal life and divine love of God.

The Catechism teaches

1024 This perfect life with the Most Blessed Trinity - this communion of life and love with the Trinity, with the Virgin Mary, the angels and all the blessed - is called "heaven." Heaven is the ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness.

1025 To live in heaven is "to be with Christ." the elect live "in Christ," but they retain, or rather find, their true identity, their own name.

For life is to be with Christ; where Christ is, there is life, there is the kingdom.

This weekend Holy Mother Church invites us to remember our beloved dead. In the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, we are praying for the souls of loved ones, even those persons who have died and left our company, to attain that fullness of life. Though dead in the world, we can pray that they truly live. By our offerings and sacrifices, we can assist our beloved dead in reaching their full potential and perfect union with God.

Again, the Catechism continues

1032 This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin." From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead:

Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them.

Do not doubt the power of your prayer.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in our Lord Jesus Christ.

As your bishop, one of my greatest responsibilities is to ensure that the faithful of our diocese will always have good and holy priests to shepherd them. And yet, priestly vocations are never the work of one person alone. They arise when the whole Church prays for, encourages, and calls forth those men whom God has chosen.

For this reason, our diocese is launching a special **Called by Name campaign on November 8-9**, during which I ask that you help me identify young men who demonstrate faith, generosity, and leadership.


