Please consult your attorney in creating both a will and a testamentary codicil as there may be requirements specific to your situation. There are also free online services that can help you being the process, such as freewill.com and mycatholicwill.com¹.

While Blessed Trinity Parish is not engaged in legal or tax advisory service, the following language may be helpful:

I give, devise, and bequeath _____% of my estate (or \$ _____) to Blessed Trinity Parish, to be used for the following purpose _____ (e.g. general support, faith formation programming, clergy support, building maintenance). If, in the opinion of the Parish, all or part of the funds cannot be applied in conformance with the purposes stated, Blessed Trinity Parish may use the funds for such other purposes as the Parish deems practicable to effect the intent of the donor. All decisions of the Parish in the exercise of its discretion in this regard shall be final and binding on all concerned parties.
