

Rules on Fast and Abstinence

Church law (Code of Canon Law, #1249f) designates that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

- The law of fast (only one full meal each day, two light meals and nothing between meals) **obliges everyone 18 years through 59 years.**
- The law of abstinence (not eating meat) **obliges everyone 14 years and over.**
