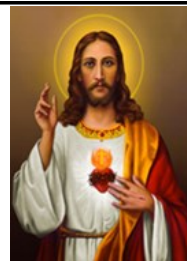
Sanctuary Lights

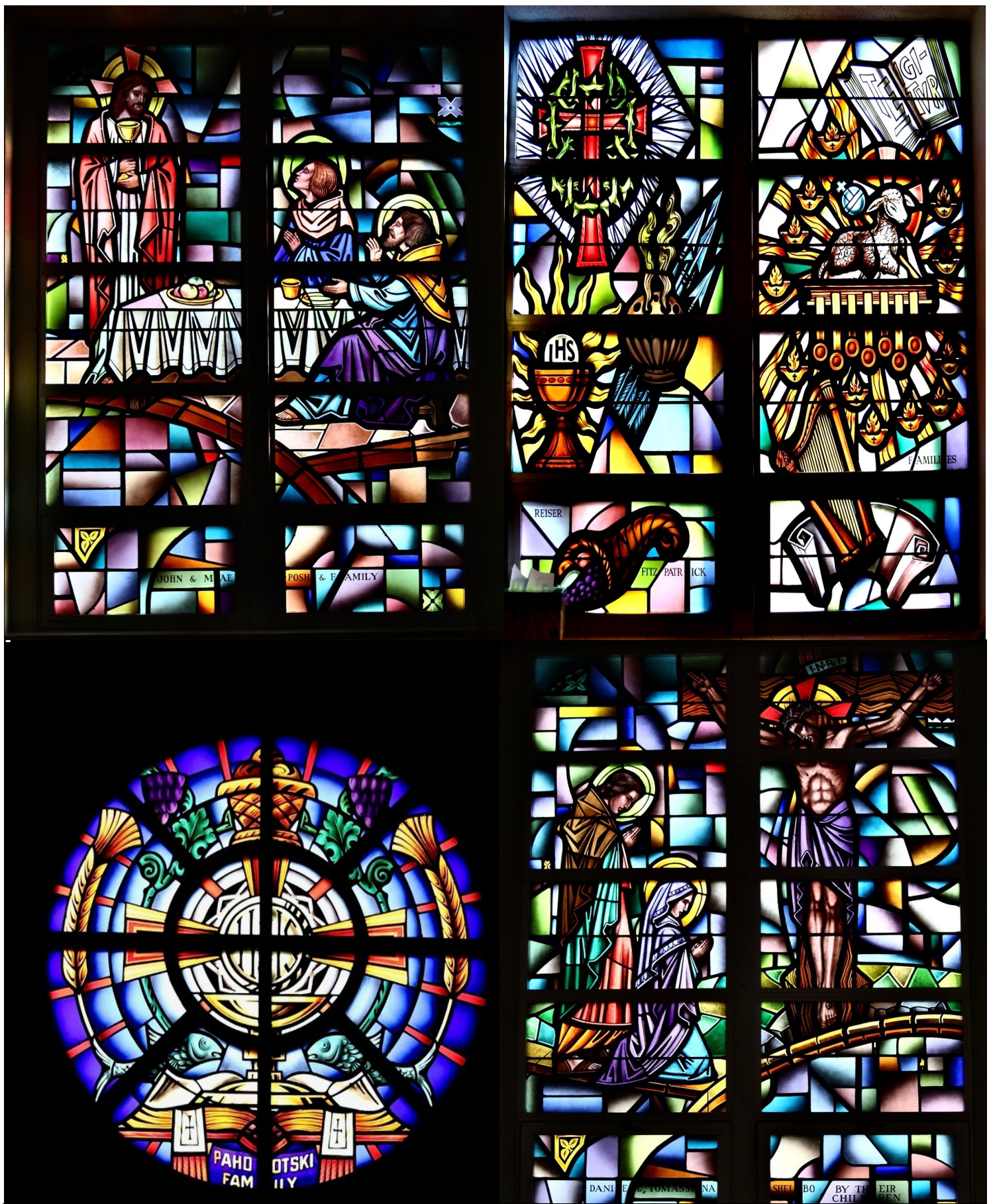
Fr. Paul is Returning!
