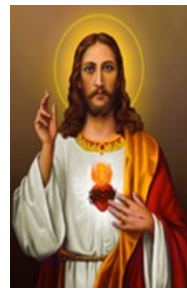
Sanctuary Lights

Pope's Prayer Intention for June

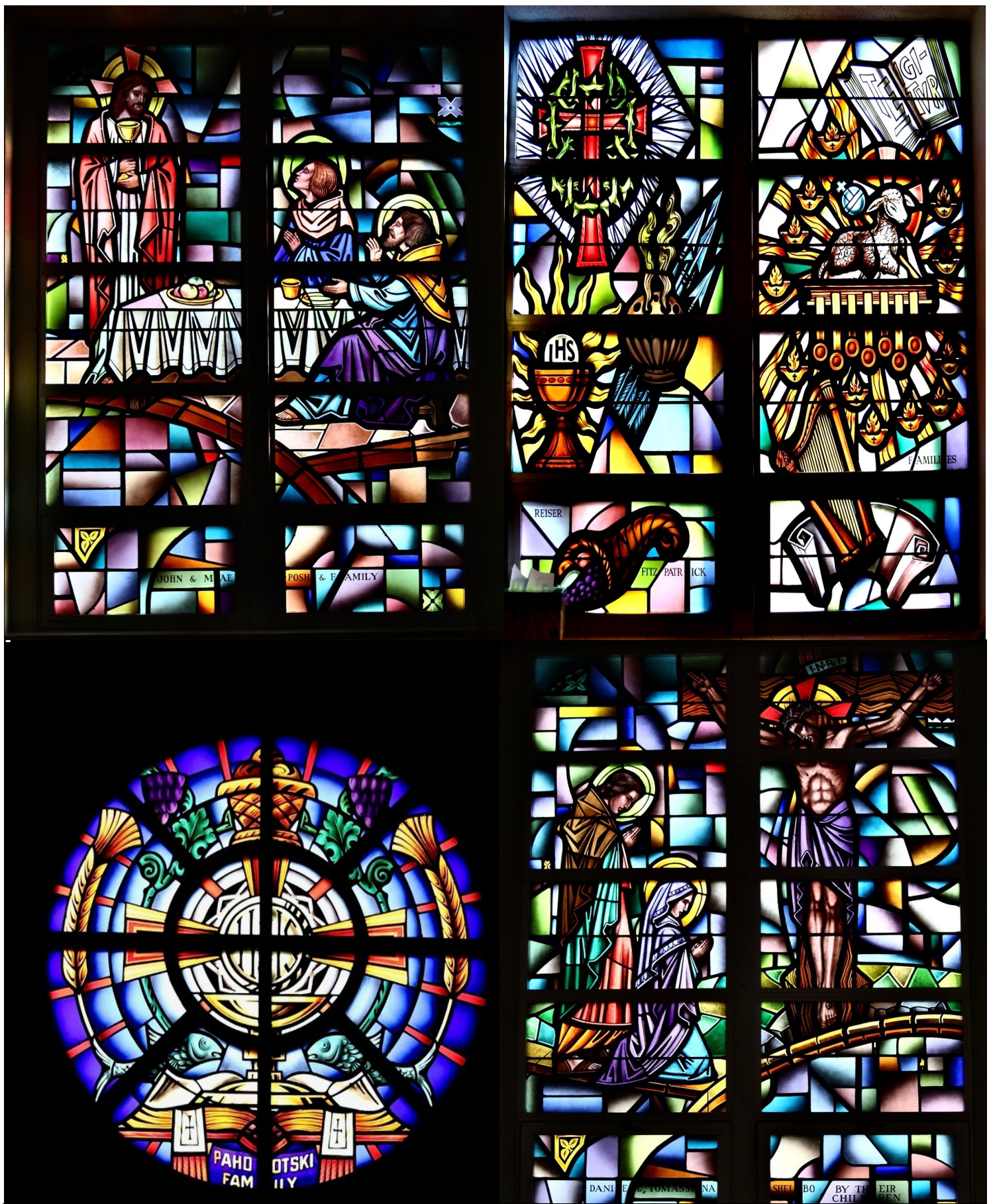
