Nearly 55,000 bishops, priests, religious and lay people attended the 10th NEC in Indianapolis, Indiana. The last NEC was held 83 years ago in 1941 at Minnesota State Fairgrounds in Falcon Heights, Minnesota.

Bishop Schlert expressed "It's been a wonderful experience here in Indianapolis. Seeing 55,000 Catholics come together to worship, adore and deepen their love of the Eucharist demonstrates the power of a pilgrimage, the gathering of Catholic people and the tremendous grace that can flow from it."
