Explanation of Indulgences:

During the Jubilee Year, the faithful can obtain up to two plenary indulgences per day for the souls of the faithful departed. The Vatican's Office of the Apostolic Penitentiary explained that plenary indulgences remove the temporal punishment (Purgatory time) for sins that have already been forgiven. These indulgences can be applied to souls currently suffering in Purgatory.

In order to gain a plenary indulgence, the faithful must fulfill the following usual requirements: detachment from all sin, including venial sin, as well as a sacramental confession. One confession can serve for several plenary indulgences (it should be within approximately 20 days of the indulgence).

Each indulgence must also include the reception of Holy Communion and prayers for the Holy Father's intentions. Those prayers usually include an Our Father, a Hail Mary, and a Glory Be.

In lieu of pilgrimaging to Italy, we can gain indulgences within our Diocese. Catholics can also gain a plenary indulgence by making a pious pilgrimage to their cathedral or to another church or shrine selected by the local bishop.

In the Diocese of Allentown, Bishop Schlerf has designated the following pilgrimage sites for obtaining the Jubilee Indulgence:

- The Cathedral of St. Catharine of Siena, Allentown
- The National Centre for Padre Pio, Barto
- The National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Allentown
- The Shrine of Saint Therese of Lisieux, Nesquehoning
