

St. Peregrine is the patron saint of those suffering from cancer. As a young man he strongly opposed the Catholic Church but the defining moment of his life came when he developed a severe cancerous growth on his leg. The night before a scheduled

> surgery to amputate his leg, he prayed for healing. Upon waking, he discovered his leg completely healed. Peregrine was canonized by Pope Benedict XIII in 1726.
