the saints for intercession and comfort. St. Peregrine is the patron saint of those suffering from cancer. As a young man he strongly opposed the Catholic Church but the defining moment of his life came when he

developed a severe cancerous growth on his leg. The night before a scheduled surgery to amputate his leg, he prayed for healing. Upon waking, he discovered his leg completely healed. Peregrine was canonized by Pope Benedict XIII in 1726.

who will appropriately dispose of them.


