

Pastor's Column

This week, as every year in the first full week of November, we mark National Vocations Awareness Week throughout our country. It is a week in which we are reminded not only of our universal call to holiness received in our baptism, but also the unique ways in which God calls us to live out our lives in service of him and our neighbor. Particularly, we pray this week for an increase in Vocations to the Priesthood and the Consecrated Life.

As you know, our archdiocese, much like the rest of the country, is experiencing a shortage in priests. When 50 years ago, we were able to have pastors even in small towns in rural areas, we now have two, three, or sometimes even four parishes served by one or two priests. I spent two years in the Panhandle of Oklahoma, where two out of three weeks, I drove an hour to celebrate Sunday Mass. It is a joy to have been a part of those communities, but it hardly provided us opportunities like we have here in the city for Confessions, Adoration, etc.

Even here, we sometimes feel the strain, as our lack of priests requires me to have three other assignments in the Archdiocese on top of my assignment here as pastor. Traveling, spending days at the Pastoral Center, and other duties mean that there are things I would love to do here in the parish that have to be set aside and placed on the back burner. One day, I truly desire that we get to a place where St. Francis can have a full-time pastor with no other duties. In order for this desire to become a reality, we need men to respond generously to the call of Jesus to the priesthood!

It is truly a joyful life, even in the struggles. I wouldn't change a thing were I given a chance at a do-over. It is truly what the Lord created me to be and to do. And he has done the same with men in our parish. Pray for them, that they may know with clarity and respond with generosity to God's call. And encourage them along the way, as well.
