**The Conversion
of Saint Paul**

1 January 25th marks the celebration of Paul, a persecutor of Christians, who became the "Apostle to the Gentiles."

2 Christ revealed himself to Paul in a flash of light that left him blind and knocked him off his horse: "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting."

3 He was about 30 years old when he converted. He was baptized and preached the Gospel until his death at the age of 62.

4 One of his most famous phrases is "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me." Galatians 2:20.

5 Together with Saint Peter, he formed the Church of Jesus Christ, that is, the Catholic Church.
