“Forever I will sing the goodness of the Lord.”

The gospel reading begins with the story of Elisha and the Shunammite woman. A woman of influence invites Elisha to dine at her home, recognizing him as a holy man of God. She and her husband prepare a special room for him to stay whenever he passes by. Elisha, moved by her hospitality, asks what can be done for her, and Gehazi, his servant, explains that she has no son and her husband is old. Elisha promises that she will bear a son, demonstrating God’s blessing in response to faith and generosity (2 Kings 4:8-16) Catholic Gallery+1.
The Gospel then transitions to Jesus’ teaching on discipleship. He calls his followers to take the demands of the Gospel seriously, even when it requires personal sacrifice. Jesus states: “He who loves father or mother... son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me” (Matthew 10:37). This does not diminish familial love but emphasizes that God’s will must take precedence. Those who receive Jesus and follow him faithfully will share in the rewards of righteousness and eternal life (Matthew 10:38-42) www.vaticannews.va+1.
