Like him, we too have countless reasons to give thanks—health, family, faith, creation, opportunities, and even the challenges that help us grow. Gratitude opens our eyes to God's presence and fills our hearts with joy. It also changes how we treat others: a grateful person naturally becomes more generous, forgiving, and attentive.

This week, let us practice faith through gratitude in very concrete ways:

- · Remember that the Eucharist itself means thanksgiving—our greatest act of gratitude to God.


