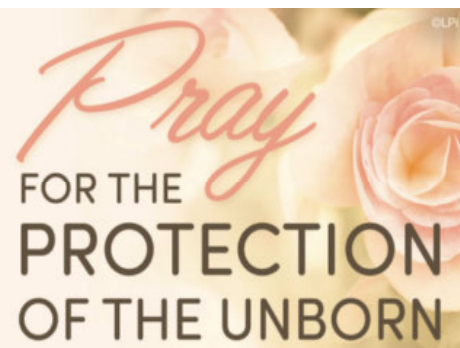

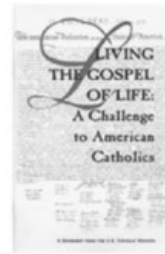
Let us pray...

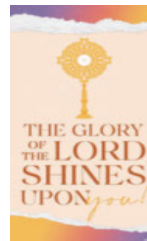
