Child Traffic Fatalities

Motor Vehicle- are the leading cause of death among children*. **Related Injuries**



An average of f 4 children per day were killed in motor vehicle crashes in 2009.



Approximately 1,900 children have died every year in motor vehicle crashes since 2000.

Child Safety Restraints

Child restraints saved an estimated 9,310 lives between 1975 and 2009.


Estimates show that 309 toddlers' lives were saved by child restraints in 2009.

Research shows that, when used properly, child safety seats reduce total injuries

for infants by 71% and toddlers by 54% .

If all children under the age of 5 were in child safety seats, 372 more lives could have

been saved in 2009.



Cost Benefit

Child motor vehicle-related fatalities in 2005 cost nearly

\$3,000,000,000.

On average, a \$55 child safety seat generates

\$2,200 in benefits to society.
