Child Identification Kit

Instructions for receiving the best results:

- 1) Use high quality stock paper or cardboard
- 2) Practice on scrap pieces of paper
- 3) Hold child's finger and guide them through the process
- 4) Lightly press down on ink pad or strip
- 5) Gently press the top of their finger down on corresponding finger chart. Note: often parents try to help their children roll their fingers. However, understand that the most important aspect of the fingerprint is that it is clear and not smudged.
- 6) Allow fingerprints to dry in a safe place.
