World Mission Sunday

The Society for the Propagation of the Faith is one of the four Pontifical Mission Societies that annually celebrates World Mission Sunday (WMS). WMS recognizes our catholicity and universal solidarity with Christians the world over, and our common responsibility with regard to the evangelization of the world. *How Does Your World Mission Sunday Gift Help?* \$20 can assist with building a chapel in the Fiji Islands. \$40 can provide support for a catechist in Peru. \$100 can support a sister in Kenya serving among homeless children. \$1,000 can provide a home, food, medical help and education for orphans in Thailand. \$3,500 can help support two girls' homes in Sri Lanka. These funds are then distributed in their entirety to missions throughout the world as they share the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Church in Latin America

This collection supports pastoral projects that enrich the lives of believers throughout Latin America and the Caribbean. These are people who long to continue to build upon the traditions of their Catholic faith. In many instances, collected funds provide the only resources individual parishes have to sustain the development of their parishioners. Church in Central and Eastern Europe


