Greetings (Boozhoo Aaniin)!

Before I insert a reflection, I would like to share the schedule for our summer picnics! For Saint Mary's and Saint Joseph's Parishes (shared time), we will be holding the potluck picnics on Tuesday, June 10th, Wednesday, 16th, and Tuesday, August 19th. These will be from 6 PM – 8 PM! And now, here is a commentary on today's first reading from Acts.

"The initial work of the apostolic Church comes to an end in Acts 15. The apostle Peter has brought the message of Christ's salvation and baptism out from Jerusalem to all of Palestine in chapters 2–12. The culminating moment comes when Peter himself announces that God has revealed to him in the case of the centurion Cornelius that Gentiles are to be included in the community along with Jews. The story of Paul's call and first missionary journey to Gentile lands of Turkey has taken up chapters 9–14, and his success has been notable. Luke's telling overlaps Paul's story with that of Peter in order to unite their work as though parallel and intertwined. But this has posed the most difficult question that faced the early Church. If Jesus has come to fulfill the covenant with God and the prophetic oracles of the Old Testament, are not new non-Jewish converts required to accept the regulations of the Old Testament law besides believing in Jesus as their messiah and Savior? A fierce battle breaks out between those who insist on every Christian being both fully Jewish and faithful to the way of Christ and those who insist that God has bestowed the Holy Spirit on the Gentiles and made them members of the Church even though they are not Jews and have not been circumcised into the covenant. Chapter 15 describes the critical meeting in Jerusalem that decided the question in favor of allowing two ways. Jews must continue to keep the law as they live Christ's way; the Gentiles can forego the rites and physical practices of being Jewish by receiving the Spirit in baptism. However, they should respect some practices of the law that would otherwise clearly divide Jews and Gentiles in their dealings with each other—not because they could not be in Christ without these practices but out of charity and the obligation of unity in Christ."
