First, I want to congratulate all the students who either graduated from high school or college. I pray that the Holy Spirit may continue to guide each student in their new chapter in life. It is a great achievement in life. I would like to explain about the upcoming budget and what I told the parishes after Mass. I am sorry for being unclear and getting people worried.

First, each of our parishes do not have any debt! This is great and a pastor's (and any person's) dream! So, we are doing well. Under budget does not mean we are in debt. Having a budget helps us keep track each year for spending purposes. We look at how much money came in from the year before, how much the parish had spent on electricity, water, heat, AC, income taxes, wages, repairs, etc. Each June, the finance council goes through a budget to plan for the upcoming year and votes on it. This year, we hired Tracy Smith (business manager in Grand Rapids) to take over our books. She put most of the budget together for each of our parishes. As of right now, we are short (under) for each parish. Why are our parishes showing a negative? This could be for a few reasons. A) Not enough monetary donations; B) inflation; C) not fundraising enough. So, we as a parish need to find ways to raise money to offset the cost for the upcoming year's budget. If we can't, then we must use the money in our banking accounts to pay off the difference. So, to help raise money to offset the costs, Rick, Liann, and I have fundraisers in mind, and are asking our parishioners/community to chip in and help at the fundraiser by volunteering.



I want to thank all those who volunteer for this dinner. But we are looking at raising money for our faith formation department, to help offset that cost.
