A Continuation of the Pastoral Letter

In the tender compassion of our God, the dawn from on high is breaking upon us. We have never been and will never be left on our own. It is God the Father Who has created us as His beloved sons and daughters, made in His image and likeness. And God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16). And it is God the Father and Son who lovingly pour upon us and through us the in-breaking Holy Spirit of Pentecost healing, hope and joy! As disciples in this divinely revealed moment of dawning, we walk from darkness into His light. In this awakening moment, as disciples on mission, we discover, embrace and give witness to the vision and mission that was given to us from the very beginning when our diocese was begun in 1889, and now in our own time, by God the Father, through His Son Jesus Christ, in the Holy Spirit. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak as the Spirit gave them utterance (Acts 2:4).


