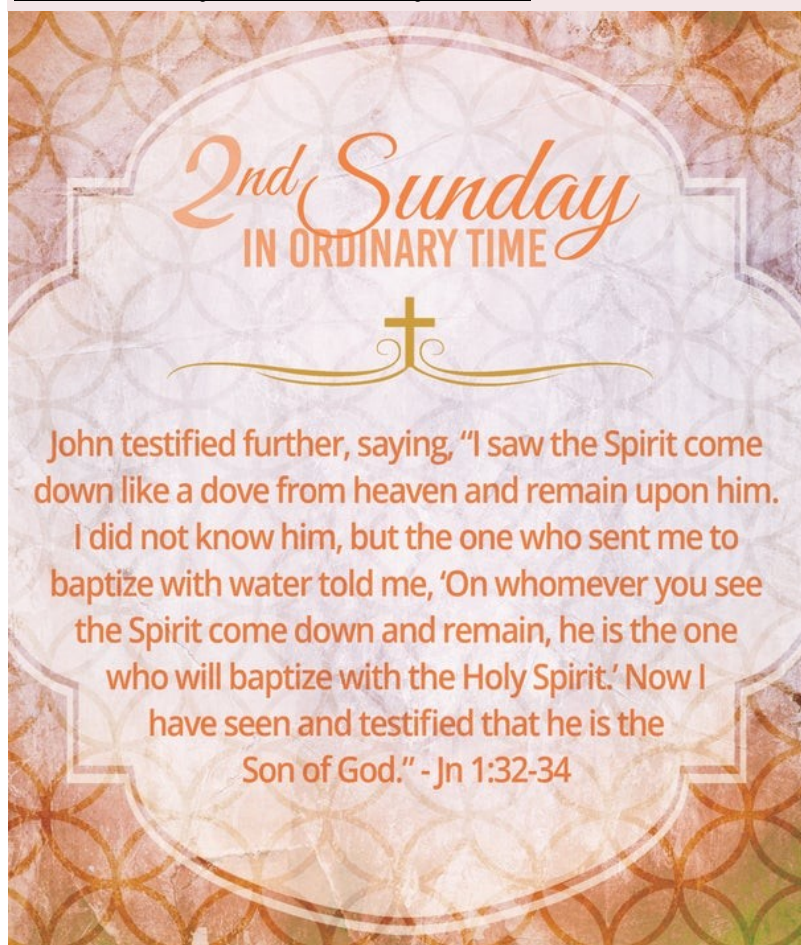

Greetings (Boozhoo Aaniin)!

All of us can remember a moment of life when we were singled out for something special. It might have been to represent our school in a spelling bee, to be a team pitcher in the Little League, to be high school valedictorian, to receive our first major contract after college. What a sense of satisfaction and self-worth it brought! We were in some way special.

Selection, choice, calling. All come to the fore in today’s scriptures. Calling appears in five different contexts. Isaiah’s servant of the Lord is called to bring Israel and the nations to conversion. Paul is called by the risen Christ to be an apostle, an ambassador of the “good news.” John the Baptist speaks of himself as called to administer a baptism of repentance. Jesus is recognized by John as the one chosen as the Lamb of God to unseat sin in the world. Finally, the Christians of Corinth have been singled out and “consecrated” by their baptism to be a holy people.

All of this points to one basic reality. We too have been chosen by our baptism. On that day, God’s love was showered on us as we also were chosen—chosen to call God “Abba” and Christ our brother as the Spirit united us with the family of God. This was not just another day in our lives, although in our culture our birthdays are given more prominence. To carry the name Christian through life is far more than a badge of identification. It means to have been singled out, chosen, and, yes, missioned. Unfortunately, today it is simply a label to be checked on a census form.

Some time back there was a small protest about the words “under God” in the pledge of allegiance. The response was a groundswell of anger and a national embrace of the traditional form of saluting the flag. And rightly so. But how much of daily life—in business practice, in family values, in media entertainment—is reflective of a national life lived “under God”? We so often utter words to which we give little thought. Today’s readings remind us that as Christians we are sacred and missioned to the world. We are reminded that words do count.

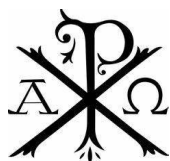
Paul speaks to the “church of God which is in Corinth.” No longer is it solely the church of Jerusalem; the full meaning of “Church” is recognized as present in the pagan city of Corinth. We often speak of our churches as being national, international, or universal. But that is not the church with which we regularly identify. It is the church in a particular city or town, in a specific neighborhood, with a pastor whom we know by name. And there are to be found all the elements that make Church what it is. The word is proclaimed and the sacraments are celebrated. It is all within our grasp.

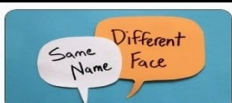

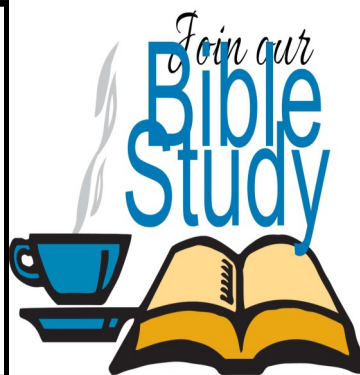
