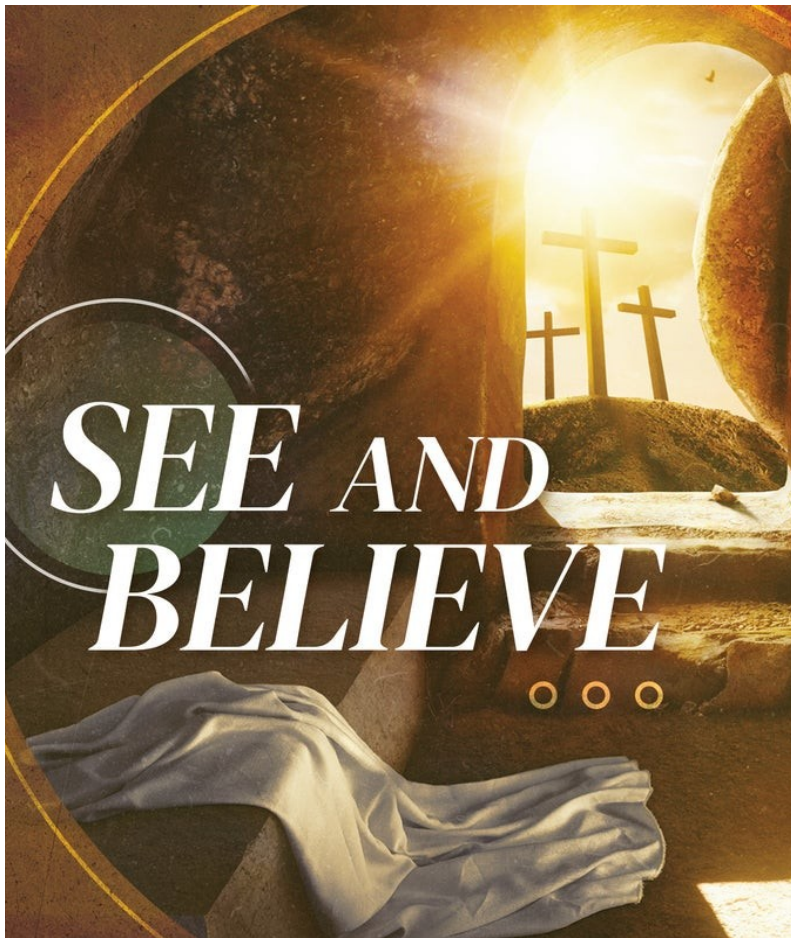

Greetings (Boozhoo Aaniin)!

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia! Jesus has risen!! We have made it through another Lenten season and now we join Mother Church in celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus for fifty days!

Easter crowns everything and brings it all together. It validates the teaching and ministry of Jesus; it brings him to a new risen life, one to last for all ages: all of this has actual and real significance; it is not myth or wishful thinking. It is Easter that “graces” us, for, as Paul says, if Christ is not risen, then we are still in our sins. This is the major feast of the church year because, in light of it, nothing remains the same. Our future is established, our goals are set. And it is both present and future. We now share the new life that will carry us to eternity.

Easter is full of symbolism. In secular society we have retained the “bonnet” and the “egg.” The bonnet stands for the custom of having new clothes for Easter, which is a relic of the white clothing in which the newly baptized were vested at Easter. The clothes, like the traditional egg, are symbols of the new Easter

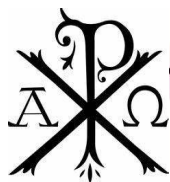

The clothes, like the traditional egg, are symbols of the new Easter life.

Mary Magdalene is the first at the tomb. Finding it empty, she carries the word to Peter and the Beloved Disciple. The two run to the tomb, with the latter giving precedence to the former. Peter enters first but remains baffled. It is the Beloved who is the first to believe—and not because he has experienced the risen Christ or heard of Christ’s resurrection from the other disciples. His eyes see only the darkened tomb and the cloths in which the body was wrapped. But his heart is alive with love. He rested on Christ’s chest at the Last Supper, followed him to the trial, and then remained with him at the cross. He was there when the others were nowhere to be found. He knows he is loved, and he loves in return. It is he, then, who in the darkness of the tomb sees the first glimmer of light.

Easter is a feast of spring, when nature comes to life in rebirth. That cycle that never fails is a sign of our destiny with Christ, which is as certain as the seasons of the year. He who triumphed over death will greet us when the appointed time comes. But the present moment is not a vacuum between past and future. It is a moment to bring Christ to life in a modern society that has such great need. Eternity has already begun. *Carpe diem*—“seize the day.” *This Easter is a part of the eternal “now.” Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.*
