



August is Safe Environment Training Month

Annual training is required for Safe Environment. All current users in the system will expire on *July 31*. The new training course will be available *August 1*. All existing users are required to complete the new training course before *August 30*.

Background check renewals will occur every three years and will be aligned with the training cycle.

If training is not completed, users will be suspended in the Safe Environment system and will not be eligible to volunteer. Suspended users may contact their local safe environment facilitator if they wish to become active volunteers again.

It is time to register for Fall Faith Formation PK-4 through 12 Grade!

Students needing to prepare for a Sacrament are required to complete the following items:

First Communion

- Complete one full year of Faith Formation prior to registering for First Communion.
- Provide the student's Baptism record to the Faith Formation office prior to August 24
- Attend a mandatory parent information session on August 10 at 11:15 in the Patio Room.

Confirmation

- Complete one full year of Faith Formation prior to registering for Confirmation.
- Provide the student's Baptism and First Communion records to the Faith Formation office prior to August 27.
- Attend a mandatory parent information session on August 3 at 11:15 in the Patio Room.
