Safe Environment Training Has Started

All current users in the on-line training platform should receive an email with instructions on how to take the online course. Annual training is required for Safe Environment. All current users in the system expired on *July 31*.

The new training course in the Safe & Sacred Adult Online Training Platform is available as of *August 1*. All existing users are required to complete the new training course before *August 30*.

Background check renewals occur every three years and will be aligned with the training cycle.

If training is not completed, users will be suspended in the Safe Environment system and will not be eligible to volunteer. Suspended users may contact their local safe environment facilitator if they wish to become active volunteers again.

- Complete one full year of Faith Formation prior to registering for Confirmation.
- Provide the student's Baptism and First Communion records to the Faith Formation office prior to August 27.
- Attend a mandatory parent information session on August 3 at 11:15 in the Patio Room.

Register and pay online using the QR code.

If your child(ren) are not registered by *Wednesday, August 20*.

They will start class the second week (August 30 and September 3.)
