



Today is designated as "Sunday of the Word of God." We are reminded that sacred Scripture is essential for the Christian life. This celebration was created to make it clear how important Scripture is in daily life. The Word of God is not confined to a book, but is alive and becomes a concrete and tangible sign.

The biblical expression chosen for the celebration of the seventh edition of the Sunday of the Word of God is taken from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Colossians: "The word of Christ dwells among you" (3:16).

This is a wonderful time to begin to incorporate the reading or study of the Gospel into your daily prayer life. If you already do, look at joining one of the many study groups we offer at Epiphany.


Calling All “Legacy Members”
