

Last week, Fr. Bird and Fr. Vic reflected on the Gospel story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead. The story reminded us that God never wastes pain, even when healing feels delayed or absent. Those who are healed are invited to share what God has done, becoming instruments and hope and healing for others.
