

Vicar's Corner

Fr. Edward Hoffmann



This year marks the 350th anniversary of Jesus' appearances to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, which gave us devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (at least in its recent form - devotion to the heart of the Lord goes all the way back through the middle ages to the early Church).

St. Margaret Mary's devotion to the Sacred Heart, at Jesus request, focused heavily on reparation, that is, making acts of love and devotion to the Lord in response to the evil of sin which wounds his Heart. Think this is an outdated pious practice? Think again. Pope Francis addressed a conference on the Sacred Heart held in Rome to commemorate the anniversary this year. He expressed the hope that the conference would work to "renew and deepen the meaning of the practice of reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, introduced by Saint Margaret Mary and which today is somewhat forgotten or wrongly considered obsolete." Reparation is about "making amends." Pope Francis says that it is from the "honest recognition of the harm done to the brother, and from the deep and sincere feeling that love has been wounded, that the desire to make amends is born." Francis points out that "reparation contributes to the reconciliation of men among themselves, but also to reconciliation with God, because the evil committed against one's neighbor is also an offense against God."

We can sometimes make reparation in a very literal sense: I steal five bucks, I give five bucks back. Of course, our sins can cause deeper and more real, if less concrete, harm than that, and then reparation should match. All our sins deny God the love that we owe Him. When we offer prayers of reparation, we are returning the love and worship that we have "stolen" from Him by sinning. Of course, this isn't to placate an angry or needy God - ultimately, God wants us to worship both for His honor and our good. We can't be truly ourselves without worshiping God.

We can make reparation individually and communally (which is good - our sins are sometimes individual, sometimes communal). The 40 hours devotion this June would be a great time to make reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Check out the schedule for the communal times of prayer offered (11- midnight Friday night, and noon-1 pm Saturday) or sign up for an hour yourself. Let's respond to Pope Francis' call to renew the practice of reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus!







La Esquina del Vicario

Este año se cumple el 350 aniversario de las apariciones de Jesús a Santa Margarita María Alacoque, que nos dio la devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús (al menos en su forma reciente: la devoción al Corazón del Señor se remonta a la edad media hasta la Iglesia primitiva). La devoción de Santa Margarita María al Sagrado Corazón, a pedido de Jesús, se centró fuertemente en la reparación, es decir, en realizar actos de amor y devoción al Señor en respuesta al mal del pecado que hiere su Corazón. ¿Crees que se trata de una práctica piadosa obsoleta? Piensa otra vez. El Papa Francisco se dirigió a una conferencia sobre el Sagrado Corazón celebrada en Roma para conmemorar el aniversario de este año. Expresó la esperanza de que la conferencia sirva para "renovar y profundizar el significado de la práctica de la reparación al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, introducida por Santa Margarita María y que hoy está algo olvidada o erróneamente considerada obsoleta". La reparación consiste en "hacer las paces". El Papa Francisco dice que es del "reconocimiento honesto del daño hecho al hermano, y del sentimiento profundo y sincero de que el amor ha sido herido, que nace el deseo de repararlo". Francisco señala que "la reparación contribuye a la reconciliación de los hombres entre sí, pero también a la reconciliación con Dios, porque el mal cometido contra el prójimo es también una ofensa contra Dios".

A veces podemos reparar en un sentido muy literal: robo cinco dólares y devuelvo cinco dólares. Por supuesto, nuestros pecados pueden causar un daño más profundo y real, aunque menos concreto, que ese, y entonces la reparación debe estar a la altura. Todos nuestros pecados niegan a Dios el amor que le debemos. Cuando ofrecemos oraciones de reparación, le estamos devolviendo el amor y la adoración que le hemos "robado" al pecar. Por supuesto, esto no es para aplacar a un Dios enojado o necesitado; en última instancia, Dios quiere que adoremos tanto para su honor como para nuestro bien. No podemos ser verdaderamente nosotros mismos sin adorar a Dios.

Podemos hacer reparación individual y comunitariamente (lo cual es bueno: nuestros pecados a veces son individuales, a veces comunitarios). La devoción de 40 horas de este mes de junio sería un buen momento para reparar al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y al Inmaculado Corazón de María. Consulte el horario de los momentos comunitarios de oración que se ofrecen (de 11 a medianoche el viernes por la noche y de mediodía a 1 p. m. el sábado) o regístrate usted mismo para una hora. ¡Respondamos al llamado del Papa Francisco a renovar la práctica de la reparación al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús!
