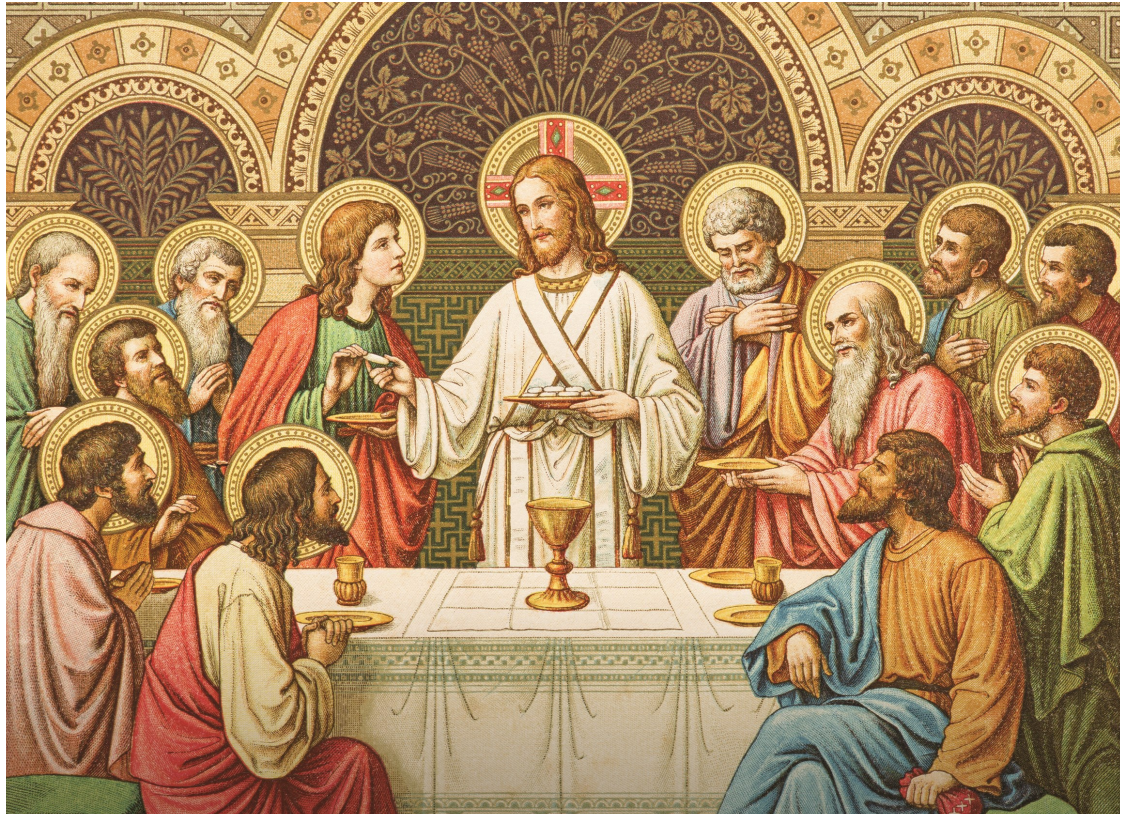

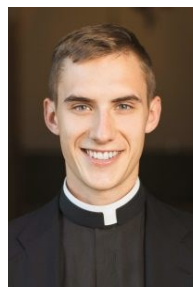

Vicar's Corner

Fr. Edward Hoffmann

This is my last chance to write about the upcoming Forty Hours devotion for our Family of Parishes. If you haven't signed up for an hour of adoration yet, please do so!

If I may be so bold - I'll make a personal request. You all are very kind. Some of you have asked me if you could give some parting gift. This is your chance! Please sign up for an hour of adoration, and say a prayer or two for me. If you'd like to, send me a note telling me that you offered your prayer time for me. I'd appreciate that very much.

Of course, it's not about me, though. It's about the Lord. This Sunday is the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi*. This Sunday, we honor the Lord's presence in the Eucharist in a special way. Christ is here - body, blood, soul, and divinity.

The procession that will conclude our Forty Hours devotion gives us the chance to make a public witness for our Eucharistic faith. This month of the year, the faith is publicly attacked in almost every town of the nation. "Pride" is declared a virtue, and an anti-Christian ideology is foisted on us in a very public way. It is good for us to respond publicly, by professing our faith in the Lord Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament, as we go on procession through the streets of Hamilton in the Lord's company. This procession isn't a protest - it's a simple public act of witness to God's love made present to us in the Eucharist. I invite you to join!

The Eucharistic Procession (also called *Corpus Christi* procession) is an old practice in the Church, encouraged by Canon Law and Papal teaching. In his encyclical Church of the Eucharist Pope St. John Paul II reminds us that "the devout participation of the faithful in the Eucharistic procession on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is a grace from the Lord which yearly brings joy to those who take part in it."

I hope that you'll find joy in our procession and the party following this year!
