From Father Walling: Welcome, Father Nam Vu, S.V.D.!

Archbishop Schnurr has formally appointed Father Nam Vu, S.V.D. as parochial vicar for our C-6 Saint Stephen Family of Parishes. Fr. Nam was born in Vietnam, but was raised in Cincinnati, where he went to schools at Holy Family and Elder. He was ordained a priest in 2010 for the Society of the Divine Word (S.V.D. are the Latin initials), a missionary religious order whose members serve the Church in eighty-four countries worldwide. He is fluent in Spanish, having spent two years in Argentina, and most recently serving at Saint Patrick Parish in Fort Wayne, Indiana, where the Sunday Masses are in English, Spanish and Vietnamese. Fr. Vu is looking forward to sharing his priestly life and ministry with us, and I am excited to have him join us. His assignment began **July 1st**.



From the Safe Environment Office



With summer activities in full swing, we would like to remind all parish/school employees and volunteers of the requirements of the Decree on Child Protection. All employees and volunteers are required to have completed The Archdiocese of Cincinnati SafeParish™: Protecting Children From Sexual Abuse - Arch. of Cincinnati Edition. In addition, employees are required to complete an online background check, manual fingerprinting, and B4 form once prior to beginning employment. Ohio Department of Education licensees may have additional requirements, and school offices or athletic departments should be consulted if there are any questions. Volunteers are required to complete an online background check prior to volunteering with youth. Employees and volunteers are required to stay current in completing SafeParish™ quarterly bulletins. With the school year beginning for most in August, please make sure you are up to date on completing the quarterly bulletins or you will not be able to work/volunteer with youth until your SafeParish™ account is approved. Mass Moments

For the Kingdom

Catholics end the Lord's Prayer with the words "but deliver us from evil." Many other Christians add another line: "For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory forever." At the Catholic Mass, after all recite the Lord's Prayer, the priest offers another prayer—the embolism—based on the petition for deliverance from evil. Then all say a doxology: "For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and forever."

The Lord's Prayer appears in the Bible twice, at Luke 11:1-4 and Matthew 6:9-13. Both evangelists probably drew the prayer from a now lost source of the sayings of Jesus. Luke's is shorter and maybe more original. But Matthew's is the one that Christians know from memory. The most ancient manuscripts of these Gospels do not include the final doxology.

At the end of the first century, Matthew's version of the Lord's Prayer appeared in a document called the Didache, or the "Teaching of the Twelve Apostles." It concluded with the words "for the power and the glory are yours for ever." Later editions of the Bible added that doxology to the prayer in Matthew's Gospel. As history unfolded, some Bibles added the doxology to Matthew's Lord's Prayer. Others did not. And families of Christians learned the prayer in different ways.

During the Second Vatican Council, when the ecumenical movement was strong, Roman Catholics added the doxology to the Communion Rite of the Mass, but separated it from the Lord's Prayer by means of the embolism. Including the doxology affirms the tradition of other Christians, detaching it from the text honors the original version of the Lord's Prayer, and praying it gives praise to God.
