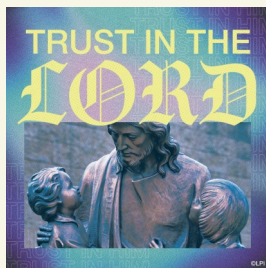

La validez de la Misa dominical asistiendo la tarde anterior (sábado), así como de los días de precepto, está aprobada en el Código de Derecho Canónico, que es el conjunto de normas jurídicas que regulan la organización de la Iglesia Católica, así como los derechos y obligaciones de todos los fieles: "Cumple el precepto de participar en la Misa quien asiste a ella, dondequiera que se celebre en un rito católico, tanto el día de la fiesta como el día anterior por la tarde" (1248 § 1).

Asimismo, en el Missale romanum está escrito: "Para que la misa del día anterior sea válida como misa dominical o de fiesta de precepto, ha de celebrarse por la tarde (a partir de las 4:00pm) y contener la liturgia y las lecturas de la misa dominical."
