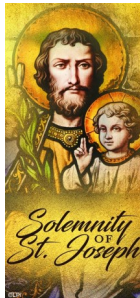

Breaking news at St. Stephen Cemetery: We now have single and double columbarium niches available for cremains in addition to our family niches. Come see our newly renovated columbarium with prices starting at \$2,500 for a single-person niche.



A columbarium is a structure that houses urns containing cremated remains. The term comes from the Latin word columba, which means "dove". We have inground and above-ground niche options available. We also have an area for an outside service or for loved ones to gather.

When we are baptized, we are brought to a sacred place, a Catholic church, and baptized into the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection - thus giving us the promise of eternal life. When one of our loved ones die, we take them to another sacred place, a Catholic cemetery, for burial in sacred ground while they await the resurrection of the dead and the promise of eternal life.

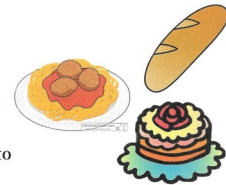

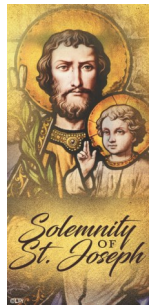

Card Making

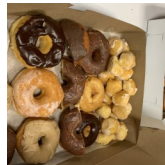

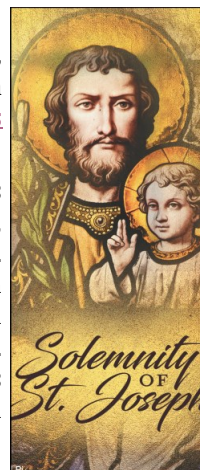
