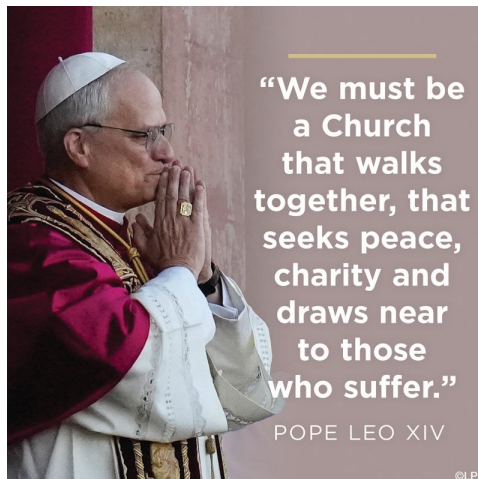

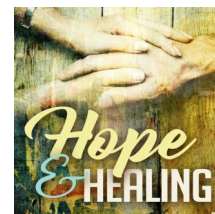

St. Vincent de Paul

Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish." That does not mean their lives will not be hard. The recent hard rains have flooded people's homes, and rising prices have left them unable to pay their bills. From March 23 – April 27, St. Vincent de Paul paid bills amounting to \$6,603.26. We have paid for utilities, rent, food, a waterproof mattress pad for an autistic 12-year-old, gasoline, and medications. Most of this was through your generosity, although some of it came from a grant from the Hamilton Community Foundation. However, that grant is almost used up, and so are the funds we have available. If you have a little extra to give, we ask that you think of our "neighbors" who are struggling.



Such as our "neighbor" Mary, whose house flooded while she was in the hospital, causing floor boards to collapse under her toilet and washer/dryer, ruining her floors, refrigerator, and more. "Others have it worse than me," she said after we prayed with her, "but you can never get too many prayers."

Robert Francis Prevost fue elegido el nuevo papa de la Iglesia Católica. El norteamericano -con pasado misionero en Perú- se hará llamar León XIV. Nacido el 14 de septiembre de 1955 en Chicago, hijo de madre de ascendencia española, ingresó al noviciado de la Orden de San Agustín (OSA) en 1977 e hizo sus votos solemnes en 1981.



Cuenta con una amplia formación académica que incluye una licenciatura en Ciencias Matemáticas por la Universidad de Villanova, una maestría en Divinidad por la Catholic Theological Union de Chicago, y una licenciatura y doctorado magna cum laude en Derecho Canónico por la Pontificia Universidad de Santo Tomás de Aquino (Angelicum) en Roma. Su tesis doctoral versó sobre El papel del prior local de la Orden de San Agustín.

En 1987 fue elegido director de vocaciones y director de las misiones de la provincia agustiniana de 'Mother of Good Counsel' de Illinois y en 1988 fue enviado a la misión de Trujillo como director del proyecto de formación conjunta de aspirantes agustinos en los Vicariatos de Chulucanas, Iquitos y Apurímac. Allí sirvió como prior de la comunidad (1988-1992), director de formación (1988-1998) y maestro de profesos (1992-1998). En la archidiócesis de Trujillo fue vicario judicial (1989-1998), y profesor de derecho canónico en el Seminario Mayor "San Carlos y San Marcelo".

En octubre de 2013 regresó a Chicago para ejercer de nuevo como maestro de los profesos y vicario provincial, funciones que desarrolló hasta el 3 de noviembre de 2014, cuando el papa Francisco lo nombró administrador apostólico de la diócesis peruana de Chiclayo, elevándolo a la dignidad de obispo y asignándole la diócesis titular de Sufar. Fue ordenado obispo el 12 de diciembre, festividad de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, en la catedral de su diócesis. Y, en marzo de 2018 fue nombrado segundo vicepresidente de la Conferencia Episcopal Peruana.

En 2019, Francisco lo designó miembro de la Congregación para el Clero en 2019 y de la Congregación para los Obispos en 2020, además de administrador apostólico de la diócesis del Callao. Fue en 2023 cuando fue designado prefecto del Dicasterio para los Obispos y presidente de la Pontificia Comisión para América Latina.

Es miembro de siete dicasterios del Vaticano, así como de la Comisión para el Gobierno del Estado de la Ciudad del Vaticano, lo que ha sido interpretado como un indicio de la confianza del Papa Francisco en el purpurado.

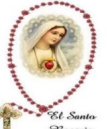
