

On the Question of 'Missa Pro Populi' (Mass for the People)

I have received calls and questions regarding Mass bookings for 9 am Mass here at St Martin de Porres. I apologize for not mentioning/explaining this publicly since the beginning of St Martin de Porres Parish in July of 2024. And I understand that there are people who have been sending money to have Masses offered for their loved ones during 9 am Mass. I completely take responsibility for the lack of information.

Let me begin by referring to the Church's Code of Canon Law Paragraph 534, articles 1, 2, and 3:

- Can. 534 §1. After a pastor has taken possession of his parish, he is obliged to apply a Mass for the people entrusted to him on each Sunday and holy day of obligation in his diocese. If he is legitimately impeded from this celebration, however, he is to apply it on the same days through another or on other days himself.
- Can. 534 §2. A pastor who has the care of several parishes is bound to apply only one Mass for the entire people entrusted to him on the days mentioned in §1.
- Can. 534 §3. A pastor who has not satisfied the obligation mentioned in §§1 and 2 is to apply as soon as possible as many Masses for the people as he has omitted.

In obedience to the Law of the Church (Universal) and fulfillment of this pastoral obligation/requirement, I decided that out of the 4 Masses, we have on a weekend (both in Church and at the Newman Center), 9 am be reserved and designated 'Missa Pro Populi' (Mass for the People). This means that this Mass cannot be booked or offered for one individual. Parishioners are welcome to send in Mass requests for the other Masses, including the weekdays and Holy Days of Obligation.

I am not sure what was done in the former three parishes that were merged and how the pastors handled this when those parishes were in existence. For St Martin de Porres which came into existence just July of 2024, I humbly wish to explain that 9 am Mass on Sunday is offered for the people (parishioners).
