

# Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word #126 Sirach 3:17–18, 20

Ancient wisdom insists that the more humble we are, 28–29 the greater we are.

#### Psalm 68

"God, in your goodness, you have made a home for the poor."

### Hebrews 12:18-19

Far from frightening, our encounter with God 22–24a will be like a glorious holiday. **Luke 14:1, 7–14** 

Jesus presents his own version of table manners.

The virtue of humility is extolled throughout today's readings. Sirach teaches, "Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God" (Sirach 3:18). The psalmist writes that God makes a home for the poor, orphans, widows, prisoners, and the forsaken. Though not directly mentioning humility, the author of Hebrews alludes to the signs of the old and new covenants, which leave us humbled. Finally, Jesus teaches the Pharisees that God exalts those who humble themselves. May God's word inspire us to embrace humility.
