

We are Changing Our Collection Process for Mass

Starting the first weekend of

August, we will re-introduce the baskets to be passed from one to the other during the collection time of Mass. Below is the process we will be using.



1. Usher(s) will hand a basket to an individual in the further-most forward pew of each section.

- 2. The people in the pews will pass the basket across each row.
- 3. The person at the end of the row will pass the basket to the next row. Occasionally, this person will need to stand up and walk the basket to the next available row where people are seated.
- 4. The usher(s) will collect the filled baskets at the end of the last pew of each section.

Our St Bernard Mission Team joined up with 100 other Mission trip Youth and Adults in Brillion WI on Saturday, June 21.

After an overnight bus ride to Knoxville, the Wisconsin group arrived early Sunday afternoon, unpacked, and then celebrated Mass with all 297 campers and CHWC staff. Sunday evening was filled with work groups getting to know each other and learning about their mission for the week.

The next four days were a pattern of early wake-up, breakfast, Daily Mass, service work at a variety of sites around Knoxville, a late afternoon return to the camp, cleanup, dinner and then an impactful evening program. Included in the programs was fantastic music, dancing, singing, moving testimonials, Adoration, powerful prayer experiences, and parish-group time.

Each youth and adult from St Bernard worked with different teams made up of campers from Wisconsin, Georgia, Virginia, and Maryland.

Friday was breakfast, packing up, and Mass with Bishop Mark Beckman – Bishop of Knoxville Diocese, and then the long (750 miles) bus-ride home. The ride home included a stop at Ark Encounter in Williamstown KY.

Each member of the St Bernard Mission Team expressed that the experience was a great one – both the service and the spiritual growth. There is already talk about where next year's destination should be.

For 2026, St Bernard has a goal of having two youth mission trips - *Love Begins Here* mission for Middle School youth – within the Diocese of Green Bay, and another *Catholic Heart Work Camp* mission – location TBD.







Shrine of Our Lady of Gaudalupe


