

# What does Paul mean about taking off the old self and putting on the new?

This is another reference to our Baptism. Most early Christians were

baptized as adults. They consciously chose to change their way of thinking and living. Obviously, from Paul's letters, we see they needed encouragement to continue following the way of Christ.

We need that encouragement, too, don't we? It can be so easy to be pulled into secular nature of our world. Paul tells us to stay away from those aspects of life that lead to "immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and the greed that is idolatry" (Colossians 3:9). He reminds us that we are "being renewed, for knowledge, in the image" of God (Colossians 3:10).

What happens, though, when we fall off the bandwagon of Christian thought and behavior? Are we doomed? No, not at all! When Paul talks of renewal, he is referring to a lifetime process. We do need to repent, a term described recently to me as a turning back toward God. What a beautiful image that phrase creates in my mind! Turning around from sin to head back to a merciful, forgiving, compassionate God. It is in repentance that we are renewed, in repentance that we once again turn away from sin and consciously choose to live according to what Jesus tells us. In this renewal, we can see how "Christ is all and in all" (Colossians 3:11




