Discover Jesus



What exactly is the Assumption of Mary, and how do we know it really happened?

Ooh! Two questions about an important solemnity we celebrate later this week on August 15th!


We believe that Mary, at the end of her earthly life, was assumed into heaven. This means that her body was taken from this earth into heaven. In *Panarion*, a document written in 350 A.D., St. Epiphanius writes, "Like the bodies of the saints, however, she has been held in honor for her

character and understanding. And if I should say anything more in her praise, she is like Elijah, who was virgin from his mother's womb, always remained so, and was taken up, but has not seen death" (section 79). Clearly, this individual expressed a belief that Mary was taken up to heaven without dying. However, others argue that her assumption occurred after her death.

Interestingly, there is a renewal of research on this matter with today's techniques and access to ancient texts. Here are few ideas I learned recently:

- Early Christian literature was apologetic in nature, discussing ideas that dealt with problems areas within the church. Since there is nothing written about Mary's Assumption during the 1st and 2nd centuries, then we can conclude there was wide-spread agreement on her assumption.
- There is archeological evidence for two tombs for Mary, one in Jerusalem and the other in Ephesus. Her bodily remains are not found in either one, even though she was highly revered. There are no relics of her bones like there are for other important early church leaders such as the apostles.
- There are several "Transitus Stories" that discuss her assumption. All of these date from the sixth century. Even though they originate from different regions, traditions, and languages, they all agree that Mary was assumed.

I invite you to join us on Thursday, August 14th at 6pm or Friday, August 15th at 8am for Mass to celebrate this mystery and honor our Mother Mary.

The St. Bernard Craft Club has been creating some beautiful pieces for our Bazaar October 4th & 5th.


