All parishioners are invited to attend this program on Monday, August 18, from 9:00 to 9:45 am in the Janssen Center.



Live your Discipleship

We will celebrate the Feast of St. Bernard of Clairvaux next weekend, including wine and cheese on Saturday evening along with the open house for the new rectory.

So who was our patron saint? Born to noble parents in Dijon, France, in 1090, Bernard was known for his strong personality and ability to inspire others. Bernard joined the Cistercian monastery at Citeaux and later founded the monastery of Clairvaux, becoming abbot of Clairvaux in 1115.

St. Bernard was a co-founder of the Knights Templar at the Council of Troyes in 1128 and helped to promote the Second Crusade (1146-1148).

St. Bernard's sermons and writings have had a lasting impact on Christianity. His most famous work is the "Sermons on the Song of Songs," which is considered a masterpiece of spiritual literature. Saint Bernard is the patron saint of beekeepers, candlemakers, catechists, and those who are falsely accused. Bernard was devoted to Mary, and one of his most beautiful homilies is on the world awaiting Mary's reply, which includes the line "The price of our salvation is offered to you. We shall be set free at once if you consent. In the eternal Word of God we all came to be, and behold, we die. In your brief response we are to be remade in order to be recalled to life." Answer God's Call Discern Religious Life



Why do we bless ourselves with holy water when we come into church?

The holy water fonts at the entrances into the sanctuary offer a physical reminder that we are baptized children of God.

As we touch the water and then make the sign of the cross, we remember that we are "born of water and spirit" (John 3:5). When you see a holy water font near the entrance to church, remember that it is a sign which "recalls the baptismal washing of the faithful" (Ceremonies for the Modern Rite, no. 44). This placement of the font and our action of dipping a finger into the water and then blessing ourselves with the sign of the cross are reminders that we are part of the corporate Church, a membership that began with our baptism and continues throughout our lives.

God invites us to follow through with our baptismal commitment, to share in God's life through the communal worship of the Mass. The next time you bless yourself with holy water, intentionally recommit yourself to "living holy lives in fidelity to Christ" ("Do This in Remembrance of Me, Part 1: Holy Water and Sacramentals" no. 6) and prepare to actively participate in the Mass.

"I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" (Luke 12:49)

Help them understand that this love, whether in marriage or religious life, can set the world ablaze with God's light and warmth. 


