Why is Mass so different today?

We are celebrating our patronal feast, honoring St. Bernard of Clairvaux! Technically, St. Bernard's feast day was August 20th, the middle of the week, so

we transferred his feast day to the weekend. This allows all of us to celebrate him together.

Since we celebrate our patron saint this weekend, there are a few key differences to Mass.

- 1. The first reading and Gospel are from August 20th, St. Bernard's feast day Mass.
- 2. There are some special prayers mentioning St. Bernard by name today.
- 3. We are able to offer both the bowl and cup for Communion, per diocesan guidelines.

Why do we transfer St. Bernard's feast, besides an opportunity to enjoy treats after Mass, visit with other parishioners, and walk through the new rectory? The Church believes that parishes need to take advantage of this opportunity to celebrate their patron saints.

It offers an opportunity to learn more about St. Bernard, to celebrate our community, and especially to pray that our patron saint intercedes on our behalf.






