

Live your Discipleship

Get holy or die trying!

The good news is that most of us will *at least* die trying. That is what God wants of us: to keep trying. The Father sent his Son to bring us back to the Father as his adopted sons & daughters.

Earlier this week, Paul makes this point in his letter to the Romans. The many examples of Jesus curing the sick, the crippled, the blind, and the lame show us that Jesus came to heal us and forgive our sins. Part of Christ's ministry that comes through this healing and forgiveness helps us to wrestle away from the power of Satan. This rescue allows us to even conceive of pursuing holiness.

Jesus shows us what holiness is. We see it clearly in our priests, our religious, the saints, and so many people around us. Holiness – obedience to God's will – is the greatest thing we can possess. How will you work at being holy today?

I thank all of you for the work you are doing in spreading the Gospel of Christ, and I thank God for each one of you. God Bless You.
