Greetings all,

On behalf of Deacon Dave and the finance council, I want to provide you with a financial update after the first quarter of our new fiscal year through September 30, 2025.

Our church support after 3 months is at \$165,000, as compared to last fiscal year for the same 3-month period of \$155,000, up \$10,000. (\$164,000 in 2023). Our day-to-day operational expenses for the 3 months are \$185,000, vs last year of \$161,000, an increase of \$24,000, most of which was known coming into the new fiscal year and budgeted for (\$155,000 in 2023). All other expenses (Xavier Assessment, unrealized gains/losses on investments, etc.), net of other income for this year have additional expense of \$2,000 when compared year to year. Thus, our bottom line after 3 months is \$16,000 lower on a year-to-year comparison basis. For the first 3 months of this year, we had a net loss of (\$53,000) as compared to (\$37,000) last year.

We continue to need church support to help sustain our parish over the long term. With the increase in operating expenses, we are keeping a close eye on all activity as good stewards of your support and commitment to the parish.

We thank you for your prayers, time, talent, and treasures. God Bless.
