



Live your Discipleship

I was at Mass a couple of weeks ago at St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Carlton, Minnesota. The priest did an outstanding job of ignoring a church full of, um, busy young children while delivering his homily – which made me smile. He said something from the pulpit which really resonated with me: "Love for God does not diminish our ability to love others. Love for God *is the basis for* our ability to love others."

So, I will not run out of love. Now this bit of wisdom may be an intrinsic part of your Catholic understanding of the faith, or maybe not. God will continue to fill us up with love. For me, it has always been like a not-quite-formed question in my mind – Can you fully love others if you do not love God first? Hearing it stated so clearly is a wonderful illumination to the instruction: Love God; love your neighbor. We cannot separate love of God from love of neighbor. This thought also dovetails with Christ's edict in John 13:34.

"I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another."

Donations are deductible in the calendar year in which they are made.

Qualified Charitable Donations, including IRAs, must be completed (made and clear your account) by December 31st. To help ensure these are completed in a timely manner, any such donations should be received by the Parish no later than December 15th.

Transfers of stock or mutual funds must also be completed by December 31st.

Other donations (such as church support envelopes) must be made or postmarked on or before December 31st.

Our Parish Office is open Tuesday, December 30, 8:30 am - 5:00 pm; the office is closed on Wed., December 31. This means December 30th is the last day for any donations to be hand delivered to the Parish Office.

Donations made or postmarked after Dec 31, 2025, will be included with your 2026 donations, regardless of the date on the check.
