

# Live your Discipleship

We will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday morning of each month starting on December 13<sup>th</sup>. We will begin with silent Adoration from 9:00 to 10:00, followed by non-silent Adoration from 10:00 to 11:00 for families with young children – and anyone else who would like to attend.

Eucharistic Adoration is a time spent with our Lord as he is present in the blessed sacrament of the altar placed in the monstrance. Pray silently, pray the rosary, or simply listen to God speak to you in this form of worship.

You can stay for 10 minutes or the entire hour.

I am still thinking about forms of bribery encouragement to help small children stay focused, or at least not being too loud. Your suggestions are welcome – and may be published at a later date.

#### **DONATION DEADLINES FOR 2025**

Donations are deductible in the calendar year in which they are made.

Qualified Charitable Donations, including IRAs, must be completed (made and clear your account) by December 31<sup>st</sup>. To help ensure these are completed in a timely manner, any such donations should be received by the Parish no later than December 15<sup>th</sup>.

Transfers of stock or mutual funds must also be completed by December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Other donations (such as church support envelopes) must be made or postmarked on or before December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Our Parish Office is open Tuesday, December 30, 8:30 am - 5:00 pm; the office is closed on Wed., December 31. This means December 30<sup>th</sup> is the last day for any donations to be hand delivered to the Parish Office.

Donations made or postmarked after Dec 31, 2025, will be included with your 2026 donations, regardless of the date on the check.




