



### Live your Discipleship

The word "Gaudete" is Latin for "Rejoice." In times when the focus of our anticipation is often on the negative and fearful, this celebration is a reminder that God who loves us is still in charge and that we await his coming not with fear, but with tremendous joy.

The third Sunday of Advent marks a shift from the more penitential first half of the season to the more joyful anticipation of "The Lord who is nigh and close at hand." The 3rd candle in the Advent wreath is called the "Shepherd's Candle," and is rose, the liturgical color for joy. This shift is even seen in the reading from (often gloomy) Isaiah this Sunday: "The desert and the parched land will exult; the steppe will rejoice and bloom."

Even in the midst of this joy, this very real joy, it is important to remember that Jesus did not pink, he rose. There is a difference. God Bless You.

#### **DONATION DEADLINES FOR 2025**

Donations are deductible in the calendar year in which they are made.

Qualified Charitable Donations, including IRAs, must be completed (made and clear your account) by December 31<sup>st</sup>. To help ensure these are completed in a timely manner, any such donations should be received by the Parish no later than December 15<sup>th</sup>.

Transfers of stock or mutual funds must also be completed by December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Other donations (such as church support envelopes) must be made or postmarked on or before December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Our Parish Office is open Tuesday, December 30, 8:30 am - 5:00 pm; the office is closed on Wed., December 31. This means December 30<sup>th</sup> is the last day for any donations to be hand delivered to the Parish Office.

Donations made or postmarked after Dec 31, 2025, will be included with your 2026 donations, regardless of the date on the check.
